INTRO

ISSUES

Firstly, what issues are important to you?

Prompt if needed –climate change/ public transport/ health / economy / work-life balance / housing / aged care

Record on sheet & ACKNOWLEDGE/AGREE/VALIDATE

VOTE

Have you thought about how you are going to vote this year?

If ALP/Lib

Thank them for their time and politely wrap up

If Green

- 1. Great! Is that in both state and federal elections? Upper and lower houses?
- 2. Reaffirm importance of their vote this election: Your vote is really important because there is a real chance that the Greens can win these seats this time.
- 3. Check enrolment: Are you enrolled to vote at this address?
- 4. Email: We want to minimise the amount of paper coming through your letterbox during the elections. Is it ok if we communicate with you by email?
- 5. Leave leaflet

If swing/ unundecided

- 1. Talk about their issues and link to voting Green this time:
  - Your vote is amongst the most important in the country.
  - This election is really important and your vote is powerful because you're in a Labour/Green seat. If the Greens won this seat it would send a strong message to the major parties about climate change.
  - Because these issues are so important we are asking people to consider voting for The Greens this time.
- 2. If going well/YOUNG
  - Check enrolment at this address
- 3. Ask for email
- 4. Leave leaflet

WRAP UP

Thank them for their time and views

## REMEMBER

- Don't waste time. It is better to spend time having more conversations with other people than a few long ones. In particular, if a person is locked-in Labor or Liberal, move on fast.
- If someone is especially supportive, ask if they want to be involved in the campaign and get their full details!
- RECORD ISSUES AND EMAIL ADDRESS IN FRONT OF PERSON; DON'T RECORD VOTING INTENTION AND OTHER DETAILS IN FRONT OF THEM
